

Michael Robinett, 18, dies in K.C. accident; services at Hickory Hill

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Tuesday at the Hickory Hill Baptist Church for Michael Dean Robinett, 18, who died in a one-vehicle accident Saturday afternoon in Kansas City.

He was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Glenn Robinett of Kansas City who have a cottage on the Osage River at Tuscumbia, and were there when word of the accident reached them. The youth had frequently accompanied them here.

His father is formerly of Henley, and his mother is the former Juanita Scott of Hickory Hill.

Michael was employed with a florist, and was driving a delivery truck when the accident occurred about 1:30 p.m. The truck reportedly skidded off I-435, and landed on its top on Gregory St.

The young man had been active in Little League and 3 & 2 baseball in Kansas City. He was born July 11, 1953 in Kansas City.

In addition to his parents of the home, he is survived by two sisters, Mrs. Bryan Tordoff and Mrs. Michael Brundage of Kansas City; and the paternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Perry F. Robinett of Henley. He was a nephew of Mr. and Mrs. Norman Amos of Eugene and Mr. and Mrs. Elmer Musick of Tuscumbia.
